

BANEA & LONDON CENTRE FOR THE ANCIENT NEAR EAST

Membership of the British Association for Near Eastern Archaeology (**BANEA**) is open to anyone who is interested in the archaeology, languages and history of the ancient Near East. The association exists to bring together professionals and non-professionals with similar interests, to distribute and exchange information about recent developments in the field, and to make information available to a wider public.

These aims are achieved by various means. An annual *Bulletin*, which generally contains brief reports on current British fieldwork in the region, information on universities and museums with relevant departments, news about exhibitions, new books, research in progress and grants, is distributed to all members. BANEA also organises Schools Days. A conference open to all members is held every academic year and takes place in a different university or institution each time. Grants are available to assist **student members** to attend the conference.

Membership of BANEA also entitles you to membership of one of the **Regional Groups** which organise their own programmes of lectures and events. Membership fees are split between BANEA and the selected Regional Group.

The London Centre for the Ancient Near East (BANEA Southeast) was founded in 1995 and teamed up with BANEA in December 1998 as the first of its Regional Groups, representing London, the East and the Southeast. It exists to publicise and promote the academic study and public appreciation of all aspects of the ancient Near East, including Egypt. Members receive three times a year the *London Diary for the Ancient Near East*, a long-established listing of lectures, seminars, talks and other events in and around London. The other regional groups are: Scotland and the NE (Durham, Edinburgh); the NW (Liverpool, Manchester); W and SW (Oxford, Birmingham, Reading, Bristol). Please indicate your choice below.
